Wollomombi Community AGM

All office bearers were re-elected that includes those on the Sauer Memorial Hall Committee, even if you were not there, of course subject to your approval.

Colin Gadd informed the meeting that the road to be widened near Green Gully 1.2kms will proceed at the end of March.

That the Mayor Peter Ducat, General Manager Shane Burns, and David Steller met with their counterparts in Kempsey to discuss the Kempsey Road and they hope to have it redesignated as a Regional Road soon, and plan to spend some millions on upgrading and sealing it over a period of years.

The toilet block at the Sauer Memorial Hall has at last been repaired and painted, with our thanks to Grant Blackwell for the great painting job. "Wollomombi Village Plan" is in progress.

Chandler Oval fence still in need of repair and we are exploring avenues for funding of same.

The review of Local Government Service Delivery in the New England Area was raised, with Colin Gadd mentioning amalgamation of ADC and the 3 other councils in the area. Submissions are currently being called for and our committee will have a petition at the shop for people to sign saying we would rather have voluntary amalgamation rather than forced, if it is forced then all councillors will be sacked in June and an administrator appointed for at least 2 years and nothing will be done during that period.
